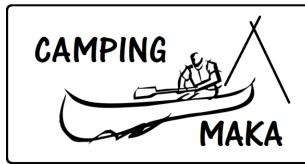

Welcome to Camping MAKA

We would like to wish you a pleasant stay at our campsite! If there is anything that we can help you with, or if you have any questions at all, please do not hesitate to ask us. So that you can get to know the campsite and its surroundings, we request that you carefully read the following information. As you will appreciate there are campsite regulations that everybody is asked and requested to abide by to ensure that all that visit us at 'Camping MAKA' have an enjoyable stay. The campsite rules and regulations are printed and posted on the information board next to the reception.

In 2020, as in 2019 we have committed ourselves to pay for the kilometers you'd to drive to come and visit our campsite. In 2019, we all could compensate 78,86 tons of CO2 emissions! How many tons can we all compensate in 2020?

IMPORTANT	Your rubbish has to be sorted out into the right container:	
	- Big round green container:	glass in all colors
	- Blue container:	plastic drinking bottles, cans from drinks, cans from food, drinking-cartons (only plastic bottles, not all plastic waste!!)
	- Yellow container:	paper, carton
	- Square green containers:	waste from food, coffee, eggs, nuts, fruit, vegetables, bread etc.
	- Blue round containers:	oil from fries/chips
	- Small round green container:	batteries
	- Big grey containers:	everything that you cannot put in the other Containers, <u>only in transparent plastic bags!</u>

Camping MAKA offers you...

- Our small shop located in the reception is normally open during "bar" opening hours. However, should you find the shop or reception unattended, please ask at the bar.
- It's possible to pay your campsite bill and other purchases by MAESTRO card (debit), but not by credit cards. The minimum amount to be paid by cards is € 75,00.
- Bar and restaurant, open from 9:00 and serving meals and drinks. Opening hours are shown on the information board next to the door at the bar. Take away: chips, snacks, pizzas. Restaurant only when asked in advance (max. 1 pitch at a time). Last drinks are served 30 minutes before closing.
- Our terrace to enjoy your meal or drink. Please respect the "no smoking" signs...
- WIFI is taken from a satellite and so very expensive and slow. Vouchers for sale in the reception. 100MB € 3,50 or 500Mb € 10,00.
- Washing machine and tumble dryer (coins).
- In the bar is a small library for our customers and made possible with the help and books of our customers. We have some books in English for you, but would like some more for our English-speaking campers, so if you would like to visit us and you've got some books to give away...
- There's a special drainage-canal for "grey-water" from camping cars at the stairs of the sanitary building. Around the corner, we've installed a special drainage-point for your chemical toilets.

For sale...

- The transparent garbage bags
- From season 2020 we'll ask you for € 2,50 bond for our cotton reusable bread bag which we'll refund to you when you check out on the day of departure. Well, you have a choice; you get your bond (€2,50) back or you give this small amount to the Upendo project for small orphanage children and school in Kenia which we support every year.
- We sell regular green and blue CampingGaz, Benegas Light, PrimaGaz gas containers as well as Coleman Fuel.
- Fresh bread can be ordered in the shop for collecting the next morning. Order before 18.15
- Official maps for walking or cycling in the hills surrounding the campsite.

- The "Camping MAKA Fire Bowl", the "Camping MAKA Postcard", the Camping MAKA "VICTORINOX" Swiss made knife, the Camping MAKA key-hanger and the Camping MAKA emailed coffee mug, camping stuff like tarps, hammocks, poles, rope, fishing gear, small bracelets handmade by our daughter Yva

For rent...

- Wooden chalets for 4 or 5 peoples, BBQ's, fire bowls, cooking pot for the campfire, grill for the campfire, hammocks etc.

Mountain bike hire...

- If you want to hire mountain bikes there is a possibility to hire them at Cap Nature in Bertrix. You have to phone them first and reserve the bikes: 0488/285820 you need.

Canoe and kayak hire...

- You can hire canoes at several places along the river. You can either go upstream or downstream the river. Upstream: Les Ochay 061/414061 (Mortehan-MAKA). We've got a hike for you to the rental so you walk (2 hours) upstream and come back by canoe. Downstream: Semois-Kayaks 0475/247423 (Bouillon-Poupehan)

General rules...

- You are obliged to read the extensive rules on the wooden board at the garbage containers. There is important information about your safety in case of fire, evacuation, Police, Fire Department, Doctors, Hospital etc.
- Arrivals are welcome from 09:00 till 19:00. After 19:00 the campsite is closed!
- Between 22:00 in the evening and 08:00 in the morning we wish to have absolute quietness on our campsite for all our guests. The use of all vehicles after 22:00 on the campsite must be minimized!
- If you want to have visitors during your camping holiday at our site, you need to inform us in advance. The tariff is € 5,00 per person (9:00-20:00). If they want to stay overnight they will need to reserve a camping pitch.
- We take our daily break to eat our meal. During this break, the bar and the shop / reception are unattended. Hours are shown on the doors of the reception and bar.
- The use of radios and also Bluetooth loudspeakers is absolutely forbidden at Camping MAKA.
- Open camp-fires are allowed at the five sites of benches that you can sit on next to the river and creek. You can also make a small fire at your pitch, but only in a fire bowl which is for rent and for sale in the reception. Wood can be collected from the adjacent wood, but only wood that is dead and lying on the ground and isn't thicker than 10cm.
- Dogs are allowed on the campsite, but must always be kept on a lead.
- The maximum speed on the campsite is 5km/h.
- Please be aware that rubbish has to be separated and goes into different containers.
- The use of a canopy, other than ours, is only allowed on your own pitch and not on the grass next to the river and creek.
- The rented cabins must be vacated and paid at 12:00 on the last day of your stay.
- Campers with their own tents, motor homes, caravans etc. must vacate their pitch area by 12:00 on the day of departure. The wooden cabins are free from 15:30.
- In the reception, we have several brochures of the activities and interesting things to see you can enjoy (in the neighborhood).
- If you would like to go fishing in the river, you will need a Belgian fishing license, if you want to fish in the creek, you'll need the extra license from Camping MAKA. With the money from selling the Camping MAKA licenses we put extra trout into the creek and river.
- Camping MAKA uses purified river water for drinking water. The installed system uses river water to rinse the toilets and we even use very well purified river water for tap water. The tap water is so purified that you can drink it. It's regularly sent to a laboratory to have it checked and it's always okay. If you want to buy water in bottles you can buy it in our shop.
